### **Dating and Relationships**

Suggested topics: how love and respect apply to both women and men; critiques of current Christian dating books; personal stories of mutual submission in dating relationships; the value of singleness; how to create an egalitarian wedding ceremony.

### **Emotion and Reason**

*Summer 2010 (volume 17, issue 2) ~ Query due: March 10, 2010 ~ Articles due: April 7, 2010*

Suggested topics: evaluating gender stereotypes; examples of biblical figures who broke our gender stereotypes (such as David who expressed deep emotion); how the Fruit of the Spirit may seem like feminine traits but are actually meant for both women and men; an accessible explanation of Greek dualism and how it still influences us today; a review of *Desperate Women of the Bible*.

### **Building Bridges**

*Autumn 2010 (volume 17, issue 3) ~ Query due: June 9, 2010 ~ Articles due: July 7, 2010*

Suggested topics: personal stories of how finding biblical equality saved your faith; how biblical equality can be an evangelism tool to people of other religions (such as Wicca or Islam); how biblical equality strengthened your marriage

(how it built a bridge between you and your spouse); how embracing biblical equality has brought greater unity to your church; how belief in biblical equality has spurred activism for women and children in your community.

## **Fiction and Creative Writing**

*Winter 2010 (volume 17, issue 4) ~ Query due: Sept. 8, 2010 ~ Articles due: Oct. 6, 2010*

Using the arts (poems, short stories, skits, parables, cartoons, photography, and original art, etc.) to enlarge the theological premise of biblical equality.
