CBE offers scholarships to domestic and international applicants who show promise and experience with the scope of work that CBE does. We ask that our scholarship recipients:

1. Complete an application form (pages 2-4) and submit it no later than June 20, 2017.
2. Agree with CBE's Statement of Faith (page 4).
3. Understand and agree to volunteer at least 8-15 hours either before, during, or after the conference.
4. Provide a letter of recommendation and 2-3 references.
5. Provide any documents that will build your case for a need-based scholarship (pay stubs, tuition invoices, etc.)
6. Provide any documents that will show your history and example of advocating for egalitarianism.
7. Understand that CBE will attempt to select from applicants who have not been to our conferences before.

When completing your application, please highlight to the best of your ability, any skills that would showcase the benefits of you receiving a scholarship.
